What is a covenant?

It is a **promise** made binding by a solemn oath. Christians are a covenant people. God made a covenant with his people. We have read and studied about these covenants in scripture. We, as members of his body the church continue to be a part of this covenant tradition through our Baptism.

What is confirmation?

This instruction helps a person to identify more deeply with the Christian community and participate more fully in its mission. It is part of our Baptismal promise we make to "*provide for instruction of the Christian faith*". In the fulfillment of the Baptismal promise is the shared responsibility of parents, confirmands and the entire congregation.
